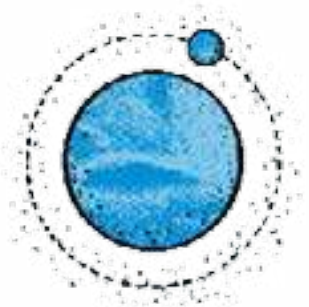
ALICIA RIUS

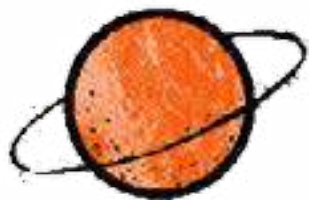


DANIEL J. BOBADILLA B.
